Determiners :- यह एक type Adjective ही होता है, जो Noun के बारे में जानकारी देता है।

## Each :-

1) Each → Pronoun (sub/obj का काम करने में सक्षम होता है)  
→ Determiner (Each + Noun)

2) Each of + Noun (Plural)

3) Each: Noun की total संख्या 2 हो सकती है या 2 से अधिक हो सकती है।

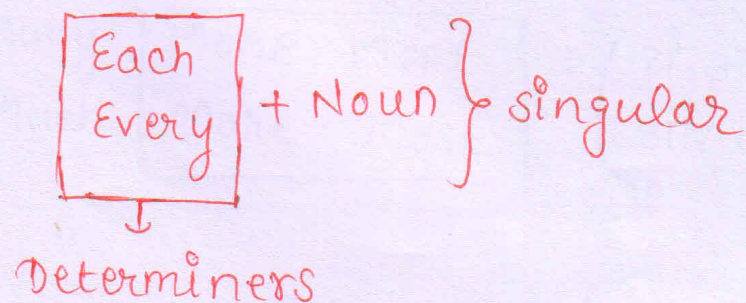
## Every :-

1) Every → Determiner (Every + Noun)  
→ Pronoun (इसका काम नहीं कर सकता)

2) Every: Noun की संख्या 2 से अधिक होती है।

→ Each of the players is ready to perform in this match.

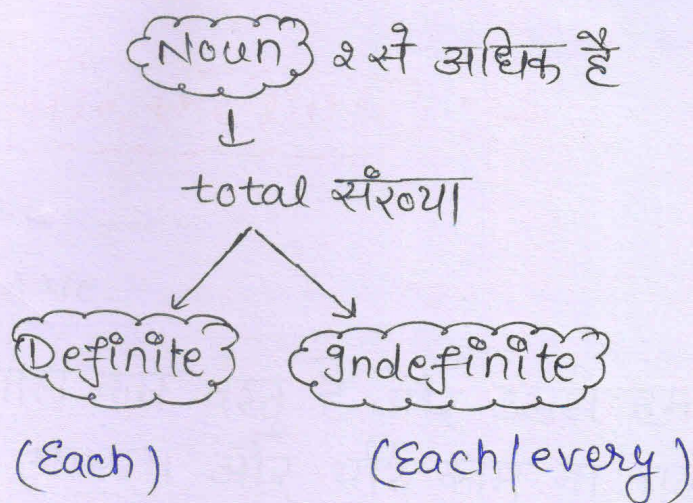
→ I want to investigate each of them.





→ He can write with each hand.

→ Each month has at least four sundays.

→ Each player of the team.

\* Much : Uncountable noun (singular) → Much water  
Many : countable noun → Many boys

→ Many More Most → (यै अपने अनुसार countable)  
→ Much More Most → (और uncountable देखते हैं)

\* Little, a little, the little → uncountable Noun के पहले  
OR  
few, a few, the few → countable Noun के पहले

i) Little, a little, the little :-

Little → -ve

a little → +ve.

\* यदि हमारे पास कम वस्तु है और उससे हमारा ही धारा तो a little आरगा और यदि काम ना चले तो little आरगा, और वो uncountable noun होनी चाहिए।

→ There is little water in the bucket that I can't take a bath.

→ There is a little tea in the jar. We both can manage.

ii) few, a few :-

few → -ve

a few → +ve

\* यदि हमारे पास कम वस्तु है और उससे हमारा कम चल धारा, तो a few आरगा और यदि काम ना चले तो few आरगा, लेकिन ये countable noun के case में होता है।

→ few tickets are sold so we have to cancel the show.

→ I will continue my class as a few students reach the institute proceeding heavy rain.



**few/little** :- (Negative words) जिस clause में इनका प्रयोग होगा, उसमें Not नहीं आयेगा

\* **very (+ve) few/little + Noun**  
**only (-ve) a few/a little + Noun**

→ very little gold.

→ very few boys, only a little water.

\* **The little** → uncountable  
**The few** → countable.

\* the few/the little + Noun + that clause.  
(जब से total को Represent करें)

\* a few/a little + **of** + Noun + that clause.

→ I have spent the little money that my father gave me.

→ The few boys that joined the seminar left for their home.

**Little** → **less** → **least** } uncountable noun.  
**few** → **fewer** → **fewest** } countable noun
